

School Wide Plan for Enterprise Elementary

Enterprise Elementary's mission is that all students will achieve at high levels. To achieve this mission, we will use a variety of interventions and extensions to help students grow and have success. These will be separated into two areas of focus: the students who didn't get it and those that got it. For those that are having problems mastering the GVCs and other skills we will use tier 2 and 3 interventions during school time, ESL interventions, LLI program for the struggling readers, and after school interventions. We will also be utilizing a new intervention program in the computer lab called iReady. Then for those that are getting the work and succeeding we are going to provide extensions for them to delve deeper into subjects. We also have choir, band, and string instrument classes to help them succeed in the arts.

We have strong parent community involvement in our school. To help this grow, we are holding 3-4 parent nights to have the parents come and learn with their students about math, reading and technology. We have a monthly morning reading party where the parents come and read with their students and then eat a treat. We also have a very well run take home leveled library and family members are encouraged to read these books with their children. We are being more diligent in our parent communication. We are providing both a print newsletter and digital newsletter for parents. We are becoming stronger in our social media presence. We are constantly posting on Facebook the great things happening and the upcoming events.

Finally, we are building teacher relations with each other and our students using the Professional Learning Community model. Our teachers meet together to talk about their students and how they can help each other in helping their students. We are sending them to trainings and conferences to help them grow professionally. We have experts coming into the school to provide other professional development.

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
