March 4th: Wacky Wednesday

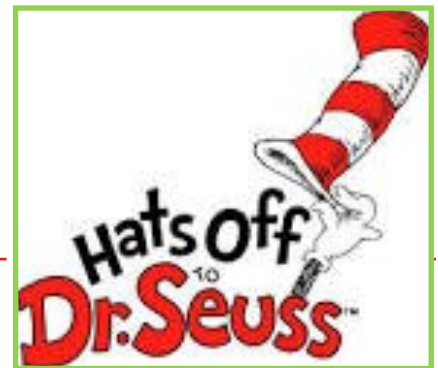
Wear Big Pattern Clothes, such as clothes with big dots, stripes and other big patterns.
