Goal #1 Goal

At Sandstone Elementary we are dedicated to helping our students get a well-rounded education. In order to accomplish this we will hire a part time music teacher. She/He will help our students make their own music through singing and playing instruments. Our music teacher will also collaborate with grade level teams about how they can incorporate music into their lessons to help with student learning.

- Writing

- Social Studies

Measurements

To determine if we are making progress towards the goal, we will have our music teacher collaborate with each grade level team at least one time per month to discuss curriculum being taught, specifically reading and math. The desired outcome is to have the music teacher incorporate music into these subjects so the students have an alternate way of learning the content.

Action Plan Steps

First, we will hire a part time music teacher.
Second, we arrange at least monthly meetings with the music teacher and our grade level teams.

Goal #2 Goal

Our goal at Sandstone is to have our students leave here being fluent readers. We will hire 6 paraprofessionals to assist our grade level teams in teacher students reading interventions.

- Reading
- Mathematics
- Writing
- Science
- Social Studies

Measurements

We will use DIBELS as the measurement to determine if we are making progress towards our goal. We will also conduct a core phonics assessment on each student at the beginning, middle, and end of year to determine within DIBELS what the exact needs are in their reading.

Action Plan Steps

First we will hire 6 reading paraprofessionals.
Second, we will train the paraprofessionals so they will be able to assist our teachers in reading intervention.
Finally, we will monitor what they are doing with their students to see if they are effective in what they are helping with.
