Kindergarten Registration Dates and Information

Kindergarten online registration is now available for the 2022-2023 school year.

Please carefully read the registration steps below.

Step 1: Fill-out the registration online at: https://www.washk12.org/student-services/registration.

The online registration must be completed before making an appointment.

Step 2: On Tuesday, March 1st, after submitting the online registration, call Bloomington Elementary at 435-673-6266 to schedule an appointment to complete the registration process. We will be scheduling appointments for Wednesday, March 2nd through Friday, March 4th. Please note that we are unable to take phone calls before 9:30 a.m. Leaving a message will not count; you must speak with a secretary to set-up your appointment. If AM or PM Kindergarten is a concern you will want to get the earliest appointment possible and have all required documents ready to bring with you. Our status of OEK (Optional Extended Kindergarten) for 2022-2023 is unknown at this time. We will do our best to fulfill your preference based on the order in which completed packets are received. Please keep in mind that your request is not guaranteed. Several factors must be considered when creating our classes to meet the needs of all our students.

Step 3: A parent or guardian must attend the scheduled appointment to complete their student's registration. A <u>completed</u> registration packet must contain the following items listed below plus the signed registration form which will be printed off and signed at the front office during your appointment.

- Immunizations: Immunizations must be up-to-date before you can submit your packet.

 Kindergarten shots are typically given on or after the child's fourth birthday. For information regarding immunizations go to: https://www.washk12.org/student-services/immunization
- Birth Certificate: You will be required to show the original birth certificate. If you are not on the birth certificate, you must provide legal quardianship paperwork.
- Proof of Residence: Examples could include one of the following; drivers license, mortgage statement, rental agreement, utility bill, internet bill, etc.

Step 4: Sign-up your student for their Kindergarten assessment during your appointment.

Assessments are done during the first week of school. Families will then be notified of class placement a few days before Kindergarten starts. We realize this does not give families much time to

make child care arrangements. We strongly suggest you have a travel and child care plan in place for both the A.M. and P.M. class scenario.
