# **MATH**

# **PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT**

# **BEHAVIOR**

- Decrease office referrals (incidents) by 25% and increase the amount of time spent in the classroom for Tier 1 instruction by providing a wellness center and teaching students self regulation through use of the Wellness Center, Calming Caddies, and lessons provided by our school counselor and behavior tech.
- Teachers will use Restorative Justice strategies in their classroom.

# COACHING

- The focus for the year will be positive relationships with students, small group reading, academic discussions, and writing.
