PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE:

Welcome to spring! Our weather is beautiful lately and I think we are all itching for a SPRING BREAK! Remember Spring Break is March 13-17. Use the break to spend time as a family, enjoy the outdoors, read some fun books, and maybe go on a quick vacation!

There are three things I want to mention in this month's newsletter:

1 - Some of you spoke with representatives from Utah Educational Savings Plan during SEP week. This is the **\$50 savings certificate** that each student received in December. (When I say each student, I am talking about any student that was enrolled BY December 16th. If you enrolled after the 16th of December, you were not eligible for the savings certificate.) Every student in the school received a certificate, almost 600 students, and only 25 students have actually signed up. **The deadline to sign up is March 31, 2017!** Don't wait! Contact UESP if you have questions. This is literally a FREE \$50 for your child to be saving for college. There is no catch and you do not have to match anything. We have sent out reminder emails about how to sign up and/or contact the company for more information. If you need that email again, please contact the office.

2 - **Kindergarten registration dates are March 29th and April 5th from 9-11 a.m. and 1-3 p.m.** If you have a child that will be 5 years old by September 1st, come into the office and bring the child's birth certificate and immunization records. Please help us pass the word so we can reach any new Kindergarten student that will be joining our school next year. We are committed to giving a FREE letter factory DVD to any student that is registered and attends Kindergarten Round-up. More information about Kindergarten Round-up will be given at registration. Leads students will be PM Kindergarten. Any SPED or ESL student will be AM Kindergarten. **Please note we are NOT doing an AM/PM request list this year.** **If you have a specific concern for your child or your situation, you may fill out a Learning Environment Form that will be available in the office when you register.**

3 - **The SAGE testing window begins in April.** We encourage each child to do their very best. You can help your child do their very best by encouraging him/her with positive thoughts, encouragement, getting a good night's rest, and having a good breakfast. We will be hosting the **Race to Sage** prizes again this year, so watch for more information to come home soon. SAGE testing is for students in 3rd, 4th, and 5th grades.

Thank you for sharing your children with us! This is a great time of year where we really see students making huge growth and huge strides! Keep up the good work!
