ATHLETE'S CONTRACT

The athletic department is proud to be a part of Dixie High School and equally proud of those who represent us - the student athlete. We feel we have something to offer every student at Dixie High School.

As a student athlete at Dixie High School, I agree to the following:

1. Have no unexcused absences prior to game, unless cleared before hand by Mrs. Gull or one of the Administrators.  
**Consequence:** No dressing or participation in the next competition.
2. Achieve a GPA of 2.0 with no more than one F in the quarter preceding participation. This must be done within 7 calendar days after the end of the quarter.  
**Consequence:** Not eligible to participate in competition during the quarter.
3. Participation fees must be paid before the first competition.  
**Consequence:** No competition until fees are paid.
4. Turn in physical and permission forms to the coach before the first competition.  
**Consequence:** No competitions until all forms are turned in.
5. Violation of the UHSAA alcohol, drug, tobacco, steroids or other performance enhancing drug policy will limit participation of the athlete during a sports season as defined in the Utah Code.  
**Consequence:** First offense - suspension from two consecutive games, meets, matches, competitions or performances at the same level of play. Practice may be continued following a personal assessment of the student by a licensed substance abuse intervention or treatment program and/or participation in a district approved intervention program. Second offense - six week suspension from games, meets, matches, competitions or performances. Student participation in an assessment by a licensed substance abuse intervention or treatment program with prescribed follow up is required. Practice may continue only after the assessment has been completed and positive participation in the prescribed follow-up is occurring.  
Third offense - eighteen week suspension from all games, meets, matches, competitions, performances and practices. Reinstatement of eligibility at the end of the eighteen weeks suspension is predicated upon successful completion of a formal assessment, intervention and treatment program.
6. Conviction of a DUI or felony.  
**Consequence:** Suspension from all games, meets, matches, competitions or performances for a full athletic year.
7. In regards to hazing incidents.  
**Consequence:** Full extension of the law.
8. The student-athlete assumes responsibility for all damaged or lost equipment, regardless of fee waiver.  
**Consequence:** Student-athlete must pay for replacement of damaged or lost equipment
9. Abuse of locker room, training room or weight room.  
**Consequence:** Student-athlete will lose the privilege of using the facilities.
10. Team room lockers are available during the season only. Athletes will be required to check out at the end of the season.
11. While traveling on buses, conduct must be in accordance to the Washington County School District Bus Policy. Students are required to ride in school-approved vehicles both to and from contests. The only exception to this rule will be students riding home with their own parent(s)/guardian(s) providing they sign the parent release form at the contest, meet, match, competition or performance.  
**Consequence:** Loss of all travel privileges.
12. If any problems or concerns arise during the season they should be addressed first with your coach. If the issue isn't resolved, make an appointment with the athletic director.
13. Athlete is subject to any additional policies of Washington County School District.
