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<u>Course Description:</u> This course helps students to understand human and career literacy. Skill development will focus on career selection and preparation and the development of interpersonal skills. Students will analyze school, personal experiences and academic achievement as it relates to the world of family, career and community. This course will strengthen comprehension of concepts and standards outlined in Sciences, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) education.

- . **Homework**: There is a minimal amount of homework in this class. Most assignments can and will be finished during class. However, if a student does not finish the work in class or is absent, it will be assigned as homework. All class work will be on the Canvas course. Assignments can be submitted online whether you are in class or at home. Being absent from class, even for school excused activities, does not excuse a student from doing the work.
- . <u>Late Work Policy:</u> There will be times during each quarter that late work will be due; one at midterm and the other at the end of the quarter. I try to accept work throughout the quarter, but students will receive a "0" until assignments are turned in. Receiving a "0" will bring their grade down and reflect on early lunch procedures. It is the <u>student's</u> responsibility to resolve any missed assignments when absent, even for a school excused absence.
- Testing Policy/Academic Integrity: DMS and its teaching faculty demand a high level of scholarly behavior and academic honesty on the part of the students. Violations by students exhibiting dishonesty (cheating) while carrying out academic assignments or tests may result in no credit or other disciplinary action. Many of the assessments, quizzes and tests for this course will be taken online. While taking online tests, students are not to have any other browsers open on the computer screen. Students are not to share or forward individual test results with any other student. Students are not to use any previous test results at any time during the testing process. - Sensitive material: This course consists of sensitive topics that can be triggering for some students. If a student is struggling, they will understand the options they can take to remove themselves from the discussion. Material that will be covered consists of self-management, communication skills, healthy relationships and what a toxic relationship looks like. This will include dating violence and how to get out of a violent relationship. Basic mental health issues will be discussed and what it looks like to live with that issue, as well as suicide prevention. Lastly, substance and behavioral addictions will be covered and how to break an addiction cycle.
- Participation Points: There will be a list of rules posted in the class that are based on respect and responsibility. These rules will be followed to allow all students the ability to learn and the teacher to be able to teach. Each class period students are given 4 points, 2 for listening/ following directions and 2 for participation. When rules are broken, and students are off task or being disruptive they will lose these points. Points will be posted in Canvas at the end of each week and will affect their overall grade in the class.
