

East Elementary School Intervention Schedule

- September-April Student tutoring before or after school at least twice a week. By invitation, tutoring sessions conducted by classroom teachers and special education teachers.
- Reading interventions, mainly Leveled Learning Intervention (L.L.I.) groups within each grade level for a half hour Monday-Thursday all year. We also provide the reading recovery program for select 1st grade students throughout the year. We also provide extension activities for our high ability students during group time.
- Math interventions, half hour daily Monday-Thursday all year with each grade level. We also provide extension activities at this time for our high ability students.
- Small group Treasures Unit intervention skill specific at least twice a week throughout the year conducted by classroom teachers.
- Success Maker lab half hour daily Monday-Thursday for each student 3rd-5th grade, programs focus on Language Arts and Math. Teachers provide one on one tutoring during this time.
- Imagine Learning program is provided for all ESL students and all Kindergarten, 1st, and 2nd grade students. 20 minutes daily throughout the year. Some students are on the program before or after school and the rest are during school in the computer lab or small groups in their classrooms.
- Homework club each Friday for 45 minutes. Each student 1st-5th is provided homework support during this time for homework that was not completed during the week.
- After school homework club. We are providing homework and assignment help with select students for an hour and a half Monday-Thursday.
