INSTRUCTIONS TO LOOK UP YOUR STUDENT'S END OF QUARTER PROGRESS

Using your DESKTOP COMPUTER:

Step 1: Go to Student and Parent Powerschool Portal at: <u>https://powerschool.washk12.org/</u>

Step 2: Sign in using Username and Password

Step 3: If you have more than one student, find the student you want to look up and click on their name. (The names will be listed under the Powerschool logo.)

Step 4: Go to the Navigation bar on the left.

Step 5: Click on the REPORTS tab

Step 6: At the top of the page there is a blue button that says "STANDARDS PROGRESS REPORT"

Using your SMARTPHONE:



Step 1: Click on the Powerschool App Button

Step 2: In the top right corner it will show you your students name/picture. If you have more than one student in the school district, there will be a drop down menu and you can choose your student.

Step 3: On the bottom left, there is a "Dashboard" button. Press it.

Step 4: Click on the class you want to look at.

Step 5: You will see an orange box that says "In PROGRESS" with "NO GRADE" underneath. IGNORE THAT! Go down to the "Standards" tab. Click on that. This will tell you the final proficiency level in each target area.
