School Program Reports/Discussion:

- Discussion on hiring another full-time teacher to help in the Focus Center was brought to the committee for a vote in using our School Trustland Funding for the year 2018-2019. Cari Bishop, Rusty Holmes and Sandy Probst voted to use the funds to hire a full-time teacher for next year.
- Bobbi Mosteller and Dawn Wright came after the meeting was over thinking the meeting started an hour later and were updated on the Trustlands discussion and vote.
- Safety has been a concern recently and Rusty reassured the committee that Millcreek locks all doors during the day, except for the front door and any visitors should check in at the front office. The school also is required to have fire drills and lockdown or lockout drills along with an earthquake drill each year. Also, each high school is assigned a resource officer.
- Cari Bishop brought up the question, “How do we motivate unmotivated students at our school?” We have smaller classrooms, teachers that are willing to work with the student giving individual attention if needed, incentives, awards etc. It seems that each student has to find what motivates them, and then go for it.
