SCHOOL PROGRAM REPORTS/DISCUSSION:

COVID Update: It has been very minimal and not affecting many of our students or teachers. The Reach/Choices building has had an outbreak and will be teaching remotely for the next couple of weeks. The building will be closed.

Went over the school plan again which is on the back of the agenda.

We are on track to spend the allocated 2020-21 Trust Land Funds for our Focus Center with approximately \$2,910.00 carry over to next year.

Our Mental Health person found another job in the private sector and the job has been flown to find a new person for that position. That closes tonight February 2, 2021. Bear that runs our Beach House has been out with COVID.

Night school will run 2 days a week on Tuesday & Wednesday after school for the core classes. The students have a chance to make up credits at this time.

ADDITIONAL ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:

Graduation for 2021 in May will not be inside. The district has stated that if we can hold them they will have to be outside. The group was asked to come up with a smaller venue other than a football field.

Dawn suggested the Washington Recreation Center having outside and inside access for groups that can be rented out, with the swimming pool being available for a graduation party afterward.
