Progress Report: Jenny Leavitt

- Our amendment was approved for an additional 12- hour para, however we haven't had viable applicants.
- Jenny will be meeting with the district tomorrow to get an estimate on the amount of money still available to spend. As stated in our plan we will order teacher projectors and computers to replace old ones that are failing. Dallas has a list of those most in need of replacement.

2020-2021 Plan:

- We propose that we keep our plan the same as this year's, with the additional 12- hour intervention para added.
- We would like to measure the reading success based on growth on DIBELS instead of proficiency. We will use DIBELS data to measure the reading goal for all grades K-5.

Other items:

- Code Camp is March 26th. We have several schools participating: 3 Falls, Paradise Canyon, Lava Ridge, Vista
- Art Club was cancelled – Why? Jenny will find out.
- Soccer at recess – girls are saying they are being denied playing soccer with the boys. When they tell an adult, the adult tells them to play something else. Somehow it needs to be worked out.
- Dogs on school grounds---can we put up signs that say “curb and leash dogs”? One school has people pay to use the grounds and clean up after their pets. They are given a code to get in the gate. Jenny will check on both of these.
- Parking lot signs – DO NOT ENTER. Jessica suggested painting on something to look like the metal that flattens your tire if you go in the wrong way.
- Security for iPads/chromebooks. We have digital guidelines that should be in place next year. With this, a teacher can see what each student is on. Our filters are pretty good but not perfect. Messaging can be a problem through email—students have to report it so we know.
