DISCLOSURE:

1. Class Period: All Student Council Members are required to be enrolled in our class.
2. Council Apparel: All Student Council Members will receive a T-Shirt. 8th Grade Student Council Members will receive a sweatshirt. 9th grade Student Body Officers will receive a sweater. Every effort is made to keep costs as low as possible. Cost will be approx. \$70.
3. Time Involvement: Student Council will be heavily involved in many activities in our school. There may be times that members are needed to set-up, take-down certain events that may be required before or after school.
4. Grades: Student leaders are responsible for maintaining at least a 3.0 GPA at the end of every quarter and remaining eligible in every way to perform their duties.
5. Rules: Members are expected to be leaders of the school in every way. If a student has had school discipline, or has a GPA that falls below 3.0 they will be placed on probation for the remaining of the school year. If a second violation occurs, the student will be removed from Student Council. ALL council members are expected to honor and follow all school rules and policies. (School Discipline could include but is not limited to: dress code violation, cell phone misuse, tardy violation, truancy, class disruption, inappropriate language, etc.)
6. Communication: The Student Council Advisor(s) will often communicate with council members through school email and direct messages on School Binder. It will be required for all council members to have access to the School Binder App for communication purposes. School Binder can be accessed through an app or the website on a computer.
