
Advisory Class Options

— Select 2.0 credits of advisory classes —

Study Hall

Study Hall is offered for both 8th and 9th grade students during all 4 quarters. The purpose of the class is simply to allow students extra time to work on whatever school work they feel is most important.

Expectations:

- Be prepared each day with a work to do or a book to read
- Use time wisely and effectively
- Show proper respect to teacher, and other students

Offered:

- Full year both days (2.0)
- Full year (1.0)
- Half year (.5)
- One quarter (.25)

Book Club on the Big Screen

In this class, we will select a young adult novel that has been turned into a movie. We will read the book in class and talk about the book as we read it. After finishing the novel, we will watch the movie and compare it to the book. This class can help you with your reading requirements for your English class.

Chess

Chess is available to 8th and 9th grade students. Students will learn the basic moves of chess also special moves like En Passant, King side castle, and Queen side castle. Students will have many opportunities to play chess matches with classmates and participate in class tournaments.

Scrabble and Scattegories

Science Olympiad

Science Olympiad is offered 2nd and 3rd and must be taken each of those quarters. In this class students prepare to compete in regional and state science competitions in a number of different events. Science Olympiad teams will attend competitions during the 2nd half of the year.

Expectations:

- Students are expected to maintain good grades in all courses
- Behave appropriately to participate in Science Olympiad

Mathcounts

Mathcounts to is offered to 8th grade students 1st, 2nd and 3rd quarter and must be taken all three quarters. Students develop their problem solving and critical thinking skills. Mathcounts teams will attend several competitions during 2nd and 3rd quarters. Participants will need to pay minimal fees for lunch and activities after competitions.

- Behave appropriately to participate in Mathcounts

Music Practice

This music practice time allows students who are in band or orchestra to complete their practice time during advisory instead of at home.

Students will have time to work on their own writing projects and get feedback from other readers.
