

Hello parents and students of Warrior Nation,

I hope the summer break has been awesome and you are ready for another awesome school year! We are excited to get started again and looking forward to meeting those of you that are new to SCMS and seeing those that are returning to SCMS.

I want to give you some important information before the school year starts. Please read through these carefully with your student and let me know if you have any questions or concerns. I have attached the files as well. You can also find these on our website at scmiddle.org.

1. The [Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act](#) (FERPA) notification.
2. Back to school night/PTA meeting on August 8, 2019 from 6pm-8pm.
3. [Emergency and safety protocol information](#). This explains what will take place if there is an emergency. This is a top priority of ours. Please read through this carefully. If the emergency warrants a quick release of students, we will release your student(s) if they have prior approval. We will NOT release any student on their own unless they have prior approval. You may come in to the school and grant prior approval in this case. Other than an emergency, your student will not be released on their own. Your student will NOT be able to be checked out by anyone that is NOT on the checkout list whether it's an emergency or not. The person that is checking the student out MUST have photo identification and be on the checkout list in powerschool. If you would like to add someone to the checkout list, please come in and speak to Mrs. Parry.

If your student is absent, please call the school and excuse them. Regular attendance at school is necessary to receive the maximum benefits from daily sequential instruction. Utah law and Washington County School District policy charge parents, guardians, and school administrators with the responsibility of ensuring that appropriate age children attend school daily.

To check out your student, you or someone you designate in powerschool must be here in person WITH IDENTIFICATION. If they are not in powerschool as a contact, they CANNOT check your student out of school. If your student leaves without being checked out properly, they will be truant. This includes leaving campus for lunch. We are a closed campus.

9. [Dress Code Policy 2200](#)

Shirts need to go to the edge of the shoulder and cover the midriff. Tank tops/muscle shirts (unless they wear a shirt under or over it), tube tops or clothes that reveal undergarments are NOT to be worn at school. Sleeveless shirts that go to the edge of the shoulder are ok. Shorts/skirts need to be mid-thigh in length. Hats and beanies are also not allowed in the building. Extreme piercings and/or hair color/style that are determined to be a distraction will not be permitted.

10. Tardies: Students may receive lunch intervention for tardies.

11. Bikes, skateboards, and scooters: We have racks for all of these things and they need to bring their own lock if they wish to keep them . secure. They will not be allowed to be stored in classrooms.

12. PE

Please, Please, and Please remind your student to lock their PE lockers! This is so important. Backpacks are not allowed on the locker room floors. They must be in the lockers locked up or they can put them in their regular school locker. The locker room has a higher rate of theft.
