Now, it's your turn to write a story in six words...

EXAMPLES

Willy Wonka is diabetic: no chocolate.

Sorry, honey. I'm stuck in traffic.

The man went to dinner alone.

He sold his mother-in-law on EBay.

Found: Wedding ring on bar stool.

Cursed with cancer, blessed with friends

Epitaph: He shouldn't have fed it.

The baby's blood type? Human, mostly.

Kirby had never eaten toes before.

Snack: Expand. Don't snack: Expand. Snack!

The Rules

- Each submitted entry must be an original work of which you are the sole author.
- All entries must contain 6 words, no more, no less. Punctuation does not count as a word. Each word must be separated by a space. An eligible entry will have six words and a space between each word.
- Each entry must be submitted in accordance with the eligibility requirements, format, guidelines, and entry requirements, or it will be disqualified.
- Submit entries online by midnight on April 24 (scmiddle.org)
- Winners will be announced on our website and in the media center by May 8th.
- Six Word Entries must be submitted online by the competition deadline. Late entries will not be accepted.
