

Next Year's 8th Grade SCMS Student Council Application

To apply for 8th grade student council next year at SCMS you need to make a **Powerpoint** presentation with 4 slides. Make it in **Google Slides** online, and **share** it with us so that everyone's presentations are in the same format. Include the following 4 slides:

_____ **Slide 1)** Put your name at the top. Make 2 columns. In the **LEFT** column write a 1-2 paragraph biography of your life including where you are from, your likes, your dislikes and your life story. In the **RIGHT** column put 3 pictures of activities or things that you like to do.

_____ **Slide 2)** Make up your own acronym for W-A-R-R-I-O-R. For example: **We Are Respectful Responsible Intelligent One & Ready to Serve**. It should show what being a warrior at Snow Canyon Middle represents to you. Make it fun. Also on this slide include a good colored photo of yourself.

_____ **Slide 3)** Write your GPA and current class schedule. Using Powerschool, show your grade for each class. Then address the prompt "How I have shown school spirit and supported my school before?" We would like your remarks to be at least 1-2 paragraphs.

_____ **Slide 4)** Write on one side 1-2 paragraphs of what you are most excited about for next year and what fun things we could do in student government. Add pics of some of those ideas.

If you are willing to go, \$180 should be paid to SCMS front office before May 26 year is out or paid the first week back when you pay fees.

We also have the tradition of getting a sweatshirt and at least one T-shirt for our student council throughout the year. The total cost for those clothes cover the year with another \$40 fee paid at the start of the year.

If there is an issue with the cost, then the counselors and I would be happy to talk to you when that time comes. We are looking for the best leaders around to lead our school. The Leadership Camp retreat this year will be announced at Dixie State University.
