The goal of utilizing these funds is to meet critical academic needs and enhance and improve academic excellence. The Council carefully identifies academic focus and reviews school-wide assessment data annually. State Trustlands plans will be developed and approved by the Council before funds are allocated and dispersed. Typically, this Council will meet three to four times per academic school year.
